

Abstracts are welcome for short and poster presentations – Please submit your abstract by May 3, 2021

4 Abstracts will be chosen for oral presentations and posters will be presented on the website.

Format for abstracts

Language: English

Title: 14 pt Times New Roman, bold font, centred, followed by two line spacing. The title of the abstract should be short and relevant. Be original, Do not use uncommon abbreviations. Use proper syntax. Letters should be capitals.

Author and co-authors: 12 pt Times New Roman, cursive font, centred (containing full first and surname). Underline the name of the presenting author. Author name and all co-author's names on the same line(s) followed by line space.

Affiliation, address etc.: 11 pt Times New Roman, cursive font, centred. Give each authors' affiliations (institution and country) and the e-mail addresses of the first and/ or corresponding author. No spacing between lines, followed by on line spacing.

Abstract: Text length <u>300 words</u>, 11 pt Times New Roman, justified between the margins, single-spaced, one paragraph, do not use subtitles, followed by one line spacing.

Funding: 11 pt Times New Roman, justified between margins, single spaced.

Details: use SI units, use L for litre, use mg/mL instead of mg mL⁻¹, describe abbreviation at first mentioning, avoid using references unless necessary.
